SERVICES FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES:

COMMUNITY ACTION TEAM:

Multi-disciplinary team approach to provide coordinated collaborative services to referred youths and their families in their homes. Services include therapy, case management, psychiatric medication management, mentoring, tutoring and other identified needs.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH NETWORK:

Multidisciplinary team approach to provide coordinated collaborative services to referred youth and their families in their homes. Services include therapy, case management, psychiatric medication management other identified needs for youth enrolled in Florida's KidCare programs.

CHILDREN'S SCREENING AND STABILIZATION UNIT (CSSU):

Intensive, short-term inpatient Baker Act facility for youths under the age of 18 experiencing an emotional crisis. Services include crisis stabilization, assessment, treatment and referral.

IUVENILE ADDICTIONS RECEIVING FACILITY (IARF):

Intensive, short-term inpatient Marchman Act facility for youths under the age of 18 experiencing a drug or alcohol intoxication. Services include detox. assessment, treatment and referral.

BUILDING STRONG FAMILIES:

A Financial Literacy support program for families in need of continued sustainability strengthening and effective community resource and service linkage; Families must be Pinellas County residents and have school aged children. It is a partnered approach and Families are required to participate in monthly Financial Education; the program is funded by the Suncoast United Way. Referrals are received directly or from social service providers in the community.

FAMILY SERVICES INITIATIVE System Navigation:

FSI is a collaboration between four major partner agencies: Juvenile Welfare Board, 211, GCIFCS, and PEMHS; it is a base to a wider service delivery System of Care comprised of community service providers, the Faith-Based Community, and the Pinellas County School system. FSI System Navigation is a prevention service, providing families the right service, at the right time; resulting in barrier reduction for effective service and resource linkage. FSI System Navigation provides support and wrap-around services to meet a family's identified basic domains of need, and to assist in the strengthening of their overall sustainability, and their successful anchoring within our community. Funding is provided by JWB and Referral is through 211.
