ENTRY LEVEL POSITIONS

Require High School Diploma or GED and six months of psychiatric inpatient setting. Related Education, training, or volunteer work can substitute for the six months experience requirement.

Employees participate in consumer care including monitoring and assisting in daily activities, facilitation and/or participation in therapeutic activities, performs some health care assignments, participates and offers input as a member of the treatment team, and interacts closely with clients.
